10 Ways to play 5-Finger Patterns

- 1. Quarter notes, then eighth notes
- 2. All staccato or all legato
- 3. One hand legato, the other hand staccato
- 4. One hand forte, the other hand piano
- 5. Cresc. up, dim. down
- 6. One long crescendo or decrescendo
- 7. Whole notes with wrist bounces on the beat
- 8. Contrary motion between the hands
- 9. With a teacher accompaniment pattern
- 10. Swing it! (long-short-long-short)

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#1 Quarter notes, then eighth notes	#2 All staccato or all legato	#3 One hand legato, the other hand staccato
#4 One hand forte, the other hand piano	#5 Cresc. As you go up, decresc. as you come down	#6 One long crescendo or decrescendo
#7 Whole notes with wrist bounces on the beat	#8 Contrary motion between the hands	#10 SWING IT! (LONG- SHORT-LONG-SHORT)
